Job Corps is the nation's largest career technical training and education program for students ages 16 - 24. A federal program administered by the U.S Department of Labor, Job Corps provides income-eligible young men and women with an opportunity to gain the experience they need to begin a career or advance to higher education

Each year Job Corps provides training and support services to more than 100,000 young people.

Students can earn a high school diploma, a GED or college credits through Job Corps.

Career Technical Training

Job Corps offers hands-on-training in more than 100 career technical areas. The corps training program is aligned with industry certification and is designed to meet the requirements of today's careers.

Training is offered in welding, automobile technician, collision repair and refinish, bricklaying, carpentry, ce-
ment masonry, electrical, facilities maintenance, heating, ven-
tilation, air conditioning, painting, plumbing, accounting
services, office administration, clinical medical assistant, li-
icensed practical/vocational nurse, medical office support,
nurse assistant/home health aide, pharmacy technician, secu-
rity and protective services, culinary arts, hotel and lodging,
computer technician, network cable installation, landscaping,
retail sales, heavy equipment operations, material and distri-
bution operations and many more.

These career areas offer training in the latest green technology and industry-based practices to prepare graduates for career in the green economy.
